

This should really be titled Professional Asp.net Webforms. 94% of the text is based on Webforms, a largely obsolete technology. There are just two short chapters at the end that touch on MVC and Razor, the parts of Asp.net that are most widely used today. WebAPI is barely mentioned. I suppose this could be useful if you find yourself maintaining a legacy Webforms app, but outside of that I can't see any reason for this series to be updated.

The problem with books like this, is that the author assumes that you already know all about ASP.NET and VB programming. I have hardly used this book at all. It really does not explain things to those of us who are still learning. And if you already know how to program, why do you need this book? Not a book to lean from. This reminds me of those water drop guys I find on the internet who I find totally useless. I don't even find this book good for reference because the index could be greatly improved.
